BENEDICTINE CONTINUUM OF CARE

In 2020, Benedictine Health System simplified its corporate name to Benedictine, changed the logo and developed geography-specific names for their communities.



Benedictine Shakopee now offers a full continuum of care including Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Care at St. Gertrude's and Assisted Living at The Gardens. In November 2020, Windermere Way, a new senior living community, opened on the corner of 17th Ave and Marystown Road in southwest Shakopee. Windermere Way has 183 apartments for Independent Living, Memory Care and Assisted Living.

Jerry Carley, President and CEO of Benedictine shared, "We may have revised our organizations, name and look, but our Benedictine-based dedication to serving older adults has not changed. We see our new name and logo as a visual representation of the renewed energy our teams are using to approach new challenges ahead. Benedictine integrates decades of mission-focused purpose with modern care practices to keep our residents safe and secure during unprecedented times such as these." Benedictine is a mission-based, nonprofit health system headquartered in Duluth, Minnesota, sponsored by the Benedictine Sisters of Scholastica Monastery in Duluth.



CELEBRATING 25 YEARS

"A VISION INSPIRED"



2021 marks the 25th anniversary of these two remarkable healthcare organizations serving the Southwest Metro area on their current campus.

The Southwest Metro area has seen tremendous population and business growth in these twenty five years, and this medical campus has been able to grow with the community to continue meeting the healthcare needs of individuals and families.

In 2018, St. Francis leadership identified both the Cancer Center and Emergency Department as areas in need of change to meet the ever-growing needs of patients and

their families. Therefore, plans began for an expansion and remodel of those two areas. The Cancer Center remodel included a realignment of space to add additional infusion chairs, the addition of healing natural light to treatment areas and a relocation and expansion of the medical oncology space. The Cancer Center was able to move into its new space in early 2021, and the patients and their families are appreciating the new environment.

The Emergency Department's addition and remodel broke ground in May, and the expansion will include the addition of six new rooms that will be designed to provide care that is safer and more healing to patients experiencing

mental health emergencies.

The past several years have seen a significant increase in the need for mental health emergency services in patients of all ages, genders and economics. These crises may include individuals who are at risk of harming themselves or others, which requires emergency intervention. The medical team wants to provide quality healthcare in a safe, healing environment.

As a mom of a son who lives with a serious and persistent mental illness, I commend St. Francis and the Foundation for their recognition of a need and providing private space in their Emergency Department for
